Born in Fairview Park, Ohio in 1992, Palencar was raised with a brush in one hand and a pencil in the other. Backed with painting and drawing fine art degrees with a Masters from Kent State and a Bachelors from The University of Akron, Palencar has exhibited in galleries across Northeast Ohio and has collectors from around the globe. During his undergraduate career at the University of Akron in 2015, Palencar was awarded the top-honor scholarship at the Myers School of Art as well as received an additional private scholarship for his watercolors through the Frederic Whitaker and Eileen Monaghan Whitaker Foundation.

Workshop Description

Kit is a well known artist teaching at both Cuyahoga Valley Art Center and at the Canton Museum Of Art. Drawing is considered the most elementary and basic form of artistic expression, yet it has the unique ability to become something so much more. Whether you use drawing for quick sketch or for more realistic approaches, this workshop is designed to teach you not how to copy but how to see. Working from observation is the best way to learn how to capture the world around us. By using techniques developed by the masters of painting and drawing throughout the centuries, this workshop will help you hone your abilities and allow you to break through to new levels of expression.
