The art of Pysanky --- decorating eggs with symbols and colors using wax and dyes --- is an old tradition in many Eastern European countries. The symbols and colors all have specific meanings, and when combined in various patterns on the egg shell, they can tell a beautiful story or impart special greetings or intentions.

In this workshop you will work within the Ukrainian tradition. All materials will be provided.

Judy is self-taught in the art of Pysanky, beginning about 40 years ago with a kit purchased from a craft catalog. Since then she has worked with other egg artists to continue learning new techniques and tricks of the trade. There always is something new to learn, especially since each egg shell presents its own unique challenges. She works with a variety of eggs – chicken, duck, goose, turkey and ostrich. You will be working on chicken eggs with a pre-drawn pattern on the shells.

In addition to crafting Pysanky, Judy works in watercolor, graphite, colored pencil, acrylic, collage, and wire sculpture. More recently she has added the folk art of nesting dolls to the fun!

Judy is a member of the Medina County Art League, the Ohio Egg Artist Guild, the Persisters Painters and a local art journaling group. Judy is looking forward to sharing this wonderful art form with you.
